

Oklahoma Joint Healthcare Committee Update

The Oklahoma Joint Healthcare Committee (OJHC) is excited to have begun our work with the Solidaritus team to implement Direct Primary Care services for all Oklahoma employees and their dependents. We know that everyone has a lot of questions about what this will mean for them, so we will be communicating something to you every week from now through our “Go Live” on July 1 of 2018.

Up-to- date healthcare news:

- In order to ensure trademark ownership, “Solidarity” is called “Solidaritus”
- The Solidaritus implementation team and the OJHC met on-site all day October 25th to kick off our implementation: focus was on provider recruiting, site selections, and our communication plan.
- The combined teams will meet bi-weekly to address questions and provide status on project milestones.
- The OJHC will also meet on alternating weeks to make sure that we are aligned in communications and internal decisions.
- November – December 2017: Leases will be executed, spaces will be designed and building/remodeling contractors will be selected.
- January 2018 – Buildout begins on centers and healthcare providers will be identified.
- Clinics and doctors will be ready to do business by **July 1, 2018!**

Next week we will provide more information about the members of the OJHC and what their role is in this implementation.
