For example:

SolidaritUS Health Center:

You or one of your dependent(s):

- Made an appointment for a primary care physician at one of the SolidaritUS Health Centers for an illness
- Upon completing the exam the patient may require medications
 - o If so, the doctor will dispense the necessary medication, or;
 - o The doctor will give a prescription to be submitted to your pharmacist.
- There will be **no** costs that day or in the future for your visits with a SolidaritUS primary care provider.
- You will incur costs at the pharmacy when filling your prescription(s)

In- Network Primary Doctor:

You or one of your dependent(s):

- Made an appointment for your in-network primary physician for an illness
- You would pay your co-pay (UHC Rainbow Plan)
- Upon completing the exam the patient may need medications
- You would fill your prescription with your pharmacist
- You will incur cost at the pharmacy when filling your prescription(s)
- The doctor's business office will process your charges for the visit and bill the out of pocket cost
- You are obligated to pay any out of pocket cost until your deductible is fulfilled.
