

Section 3.

Those members in attendance at the regular or special membership meeting shall constitute a quorum.

Section 4.

Any member who attends a meeting in an intoxicated condition and/or creates a disturbance, or becomes unruly, shall lose his or her voice and right to vote at said meeting. Where necessary to maintain order, such members may be evicted from the meeting by order of the Chairperson, subject to the challenge of the membership. Flagrant or persistent violation of this section by any member shall be conduct unbecoming a union member.

Section 5.

The order of business at membership meetings shall be as follows:

1. Opening ceremony by Chairperson (President, Vice President or Member of Executive Board.
2. Invocation
3. Pledge to the Flag
4. Roll call of Officers
5. Reading of minutes of previous meeting
6. Application for Membership
7. Voting on applications
8. Initiation of candidates
9. Report of Financial Secretary
10. Reports of Officers, Committees and Delegates
11. Communications
12. Unfinished business
13. Good and Welfare
14. Does anyone know of a member out of work or in distress?
15. New business
16. Bargaining Chairperson's Report
17. Closing

(All questions of parliamentary nature shall be decided by Roberts' Rules of Order)

ARTICLE X

ELECTIONS

Section 1.

Nominations and Elections of Local Union Executive Officers and Bargaining Committee.

Sub. Section A.

Par. 1 The nomination of Local Union Executive Officers and Bargaining Committee shall take place at the first regular membership meeting in May of each third (3rd) year.
